- To download files: Click the "download" button next to the song you want to download, then click "Save As" or "Save." Choose the folder where you want to save the file to. If you don't see the "Save" button, check the Downloads folder.
- Music files can be transferred to your smartphone or MP3 player by connecting your USB cable to the computer and dragging the music files to the preferred folder on your device.
