#### **BUDGET AND FINANCIAL COMMITTEE MEETING**

Zion-Benton Public Library District Genealogy Room Monday April 15, 2019 at 6:00 PM

#### Minutes

The meeting was called to order at 6:07pm.

Present: Jacqueline Holmes, Mary Martin, Wendy Driver, Beverly Mull, and Mikael Jacobsen (Staff)

Discussion on the salary schedule adjustment plan for the next 6 years.

- Mr. Jacobsen presented a salary schedule adjustment plan. This plan will adjust
  the salary schedule to reach the \$15 minimum wage by 2025. It also takes in to
  account the desire to keep an appropriate dollar amount between each pay
  grade.
- Each pay grade will be increased a certain % each year.
- Mr. Jacobsen suggested the Board adopt this plan year-to-year in order to allow for changes in the law.

Discussion on merit and cost of living adjustment plans.

- Mr. Jacobsen presented three merit and/or Cost of Living Adjustment amounts.
  - A 2.5% increase will amount to a \$34,800 addition to the Library's budget if all staff receive the full amount.
  - A 2.8% increase will amount to a \$38,200 addition to the Library's budget if all staff receive the full amount.
  - A 3% increase will amount to a \$40,500 addition to the Library's budget if all staff receive the full amount.

### Discussion on budget proposals

- 1. Adding additional hours
- 2. Not adding additional hours
- Mr. Jacobsen presented two budgets in detail. One budget will allocate funds to be open 1-5pm on Sundays. The other budget does not.
- The ability to be open additional hours comes from cuts to online resources, not filling open positions, and renegotiating contacts with vendors.

The meeting adjourned at 7:11pm.

The next meeting is scheduled for May 21, 2019.
