## Overview:

The position focuses on the development and implementation of programs, collections, and outreach supporting digital literacy and the promotion of library resources.

## **Essential Functions and Responsibilities:**

- Develop collection in areas assigned, including acquisitions and weeding; use informational resources to identify materials needed.
- Develop program ideas and find new ways to engage patrons within the library, community, and online.
- Assist in managing and promoting databases.
- Assist in troubleshooting library technologies, including hardware, databases, and web software.
- Provide instruction and assistance to patrons using library equipment and resources, including devices and mobile technologies.
- Collaborate to create large scale events and implement library-wide programming.
- Help promote department and library initiatives through communication channels such as social media and library's website.
- Stay updated with technology trends and coordinate training for patrons
- Explore grants opportunities that coincide with library initiatives.
- Explore ways to engage with community organizations, build partnerships, and participate in networking events.

## **Education and Experience:**

- MLS/MLIS from an ALA-accredited school or Master's degree in related field preferred
- Previous library work experience desirable, preferably in a public library
- Listening and communications skills
- Experience with productivity software; MS Word, Excel, PowerPoint
- Ability to stay organized and use time effectively while working independently
- Ability to exercise judgement when dealing with the public and staff
- Ability to work well within a team and be adaptable to change
- Knowledge of library automation such as online catalogs and ILS programs
- Aware of library related resources, including databases and digital materials
- Ability and desire to work with patrons of all ages and skill levels

- Must be able to move with patrons throughout the building to provide, explain, and interpret resources
- Frequent sitting, moving, bending, stooping, lifting, and reaching
- Must be able to push and pull library carts with materials
