

ORDINANCE 23/24-O-4

**ORDINANCE TO ACCEPT A RESIGNATION, DECLARE A VACANCY  
AND APPOINT A NEW TRUSTEE**

(Barbara M. Price Vacancy)

WHEREAS, Barbara M. Price (Price) has served as a Library Trustee and on April 6, 2021 was elected to serve a 6 year term; and

WHEREAS, Price recently submitted a letter advising that she has moved out of the Zion-Benton Public Library District and regrets that she is not eligible to finish her term of office, and

WHEREAS, the Public Library District Act of 1991, 75 ILCS 16/1-1 et seq. (the “Act) provides that vacancies in the office of Library Trustee shall be declared by the Library Board when a Library Trustee is ineligible to serve; and

WHEREAS, under the Act, vacancies shall be filled by appointment of the remaining term of service a Library Trustee until the next regular library election.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Library Trustees of the Zion Benton Public Library District as follows:

The Library Trustees hereby:

- A. Accept Price’s resignation;
- B. Declare a vacancy in the office of Library Trustee;
- C. Seek applicants to fill the vacancy effective Tuesday, November 28, 2023 to serve until the next regular library election.

D. By separate Ordinance, the Library Board will appoint someone to  
serve as Library Trustee until the next regular election in April 2025.

This Ordinance adopted November 28, 2023.


